We are seeking to recruit a part-time Asian group facilitator to provide a weekly Bereavement Support Group for Asian clients.

You must have:

- The ability to speak fluently in Gujarati and/or Hindi
- Have a recognised counselling or psychotherapy diploma or Social Work qualification
- BACP or UKCP accreditation, eligibility, registration or equivalent
- 3 (or more) years post-qualifying experience in offering individual counselling
- Experience of setting up, delivering and evaluation a weekly support group
- Experience in supporting bereaved clients
- A minimum of two years' experience in facilitating therapeutic groups
- Knowledge of the issues and barriers faced by Asian clients accessing services
- Effectively engaged clients who are bereaved in therapeutic group work
- An ability to identify clients at risk and make appropriate safeguarding interventions
- Experience of mentoring a trainee group facilitator
- Experience of facilitating and co-facilitating group work sessions
- Evidence of contributing to the development of therapeutic services and projects
- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent IT skills

The role will require you to:

- To set up and facilitate a weekly Bereavement Support Group
- Provide high-quality emotional support to clients attending the group
- Evaluate and monitor outcomes and complete regular reports and statistics
- Promote and publicise the Bereavement Support group
- Be articulate and to enjoy working both in a team and on your own initiative.
- Attend monthly supervision sessions
